



## Theory of Change

#### **ACTIVITIES**

- Fostering info sessions

- Provide practical info and emotional care

- Befrienders programme

#### **SHORT TERM**

- More reached through diverse outreach events
- More foster parents, respite carers, befrienders, and volunteers join the community
- More donors/sponsors to support familybased care
- More foster parent support groups formed
- More foster families participate in community activities
- More foster families benefit from programmes offered by network of partners
- More buddies/mentors and befrienders step up to partner new foster parents, foster children and youths

#### MID TERM

- Increased knowledge of fostering amongst general population
- Increased willingness to foster
- Increased perception of support received by foster parents
- Increased caregiving satisfaction
- Reduced caregiving stress
- Reduced number of foster placement breakdowns
- Increased satisfaction and opportunities for respite carers, befrienders and volunteers to support foster families
- Progression of respite carers, befrienders and volunteers to become foster parents

#### **LONG TERM**

- ✓ More foster parents recruited
- ✓ Higher fostering rate
- ✓ Increased awareness and acceptance of fostering by the public
- ✓ Foster parents feel adequately supported
- ✓ Increased retention rate of foster parents
- ✓ Increased willingness to accept new placements
- ✓ Increased well-being of foster family and foster child





## Building HFG-SG's Model

#### **Peer Support Groups**


- Group chats via WhatsApp
- Zone sub-groups for F2F meet ups
- Special topic groups (e.g., Special Needs/Neurodiversity, Adoption, Homes for Homeless, Befrienders etc.)

#### Information Sessions

Foster parents share to dispel myths, challenge assumptions, and raise awareness of the value of family-based care for vulnerable children and youths.

#### Find Foster Families for Children

 Assist child protection specialist agencies, Family Service Centres, or Child Protective Service to find foster parents for temporary care



#### Tips and Resources

- Share information and tips (e.g. contractor to install window grills)
- Share items of daily and essential use (e.g., crib, stroller, books, toys, clothes, milk powder, bed etc.)
- Provide camaraderie and care
- Share volunteering opportunities
- Befrienders programme
- Support for informal fostering and families

#### **Build Awareness**

- Speak at events to advocate for foster care and build mindshare
- Share activities and reflections on Facebook and LinkedIn
- Launched new website with content contributed by foster parents
- Refreshed brand logo with a community identity



## Going Forward

It takes a village to raise a child

It takes a network of villages to support foster parents, foster children and youths

Grow the eco-system of care with partners to not only support reintegration of foster children and their own families, but also support foster parents to build resilience and reduce placement breakdowns

Commence a 22-month study to evaluate the impact of a peer support network for foster parents


Engage stakeholders such as business/social enterprise, foundations and donors to build the charity's operating sustainability to support delivery of programmes


